



Child Protection Policy

Qhubeka is fully committed to protecting the security, privacy, and dignity of the children who take part in our programs.

Children have the right to be completely free from the fear or reality of abuse (either physical or emotional) resulting from inappropriate contact with Qhubeka employees, volunteers, or visitors.

Only the first names of children profiled in our marketing materials are used and we do not include information by which the location of children could be easily identified.

Visitors to our programs should NOT attempt to contact a child, his or her family or community members, in any manner other than that prescribed and permitted in advance in writing by Qhubeka. In particular, telephone calls, email or unplanned visits to the child's residence and community are forbidden without written permission and oversight by Qhubeka.

Qhubeka does not currently nor will in the future employ children in any of our facilities.
